THE BRIGHT IDEA **ROY GERONEMUS, MD**

When a laser company has a new machine, it goes straight from R&D to NYC dermatologist Roy Geronemus, MD. If Geronemus, the founder of the laser program at New York University School of Medicine (he's a clinical professor there), doesn't give his stamp of approval, chances are the laser will never hit the market. The author of more than 165 medical articles and books, Geronemus has also been involved in technology trials, such as those for the light-emitting diodes that led to the development of the **Gentlewaves** skin rejuvenation machine.

TRICK OF THE TRADE:

While Geronemus' office has a makeup room where patients can pop in after a laser procedure to cover any flushing, the doctor often sends clients for a **Gentlewaves** session instead. "We've found that two 35-second doses of **Gentlewaves** post-laser treatment minimizes redness."
